3	Risk of disasters	Evacuation of the elderly, etc. ※1
2	Weather worsening	Heavy rain, flood, or storm surge advisories (Japan Meteorological Agency)
1	Risk of weather worsening	Probability of warnings (Japan Meteorological Agency)

※1 Alert Level 3 is when people other than the elderly, etc. should also begin to adjust their behavior or prepare for evacuation where necessary, or evacuate of their own accord if they sense a danger to their lives.

An Evacuation Recommendation will no longer be issued.
From this point, all residents should evacuate from dangerous places upon **Alert Level 4, Evacuation Instruction.**

Elderly people or people with disabilities, who may need more time to evacuate, should evacuate from dangerous places upon **Alert Level 3, Evacuation of the Elderly, Etc.**

【Attention】 Due to the impact of COVID-19, the capacity of evacuation centers is significantly limited.

In case of a disaster, people in hazardous areas must always evacuate, but people in safe areas do not have to go outside to evacuate in bad weather.
