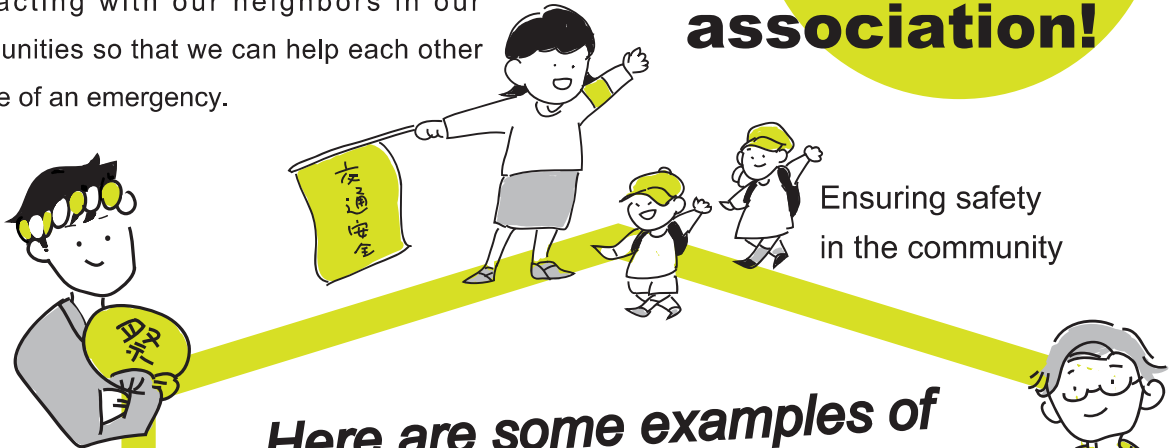


In the event of a major disaster such as an earthquake or flood, we cannot deal with it alone.
